Her work explores themes of connection, inviting viewers into deeper dialogues. Beyond painting, Eva engages in illustration, typography, and game design, pushing creative boundaries. Her art has been showcased in cities like Brno, London, Barcelona, and Valencia.

Xavi Alonso: The Precision of Design

With over 20 years in Barcelona's creative industry, Xavi Alonso excels in graphic design, branding, editorial projects, and game design. Inspired by the Bauhaus movement, his work emphasizes the harmony of form, function, and storytelling. As cofounder of a creative studio with Eva Kaluzova, Xavi contributes a precise and thoughtful approach to this Anthropocene-focused collection.

The exhibition, conceived as a multifaceted exploration of graphic design as a tool for storytelling, seeks to unravel the complex interplay between humanity and the environment. Through a series of previous works and some original pieces produced for the gallery, they examine how visual communication can confront the realities of environmental degradation, technological overreach, and social inequality—while simultaneously proposing new ways of seeing, understanding, and engaging with these issues.

At mono30, their works not only stand as individual contributions to the discourse but also as a collaborative testament to the transformative potential of art and design. By interweaving their disciplines, they amplify the urgency of the Anthropocene's message while showcasing the inherent adaptability and diversity of creative expression. This temporary exhibition underscores how art and design can inspire deeper engagement with the defining questions of our age—an invitation for audiences to reflect on their role within a shared and uncertain future.
